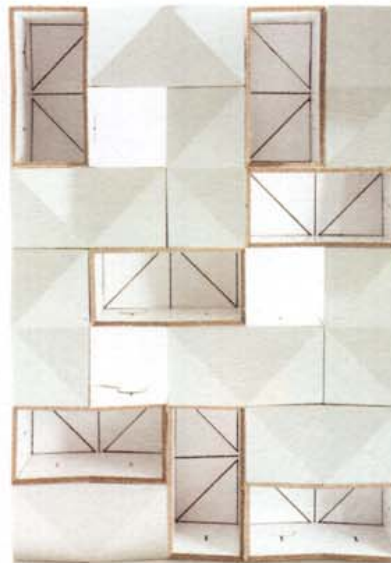
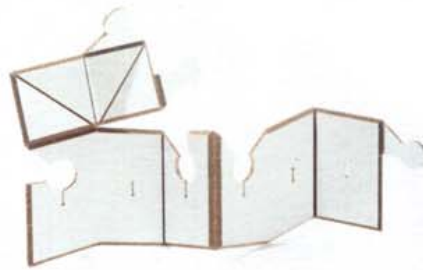

## Porcini Stem

Inspired by the trembling delicacy of mushrooms, the Porcini Stem was designed by Jaquie Hagan and Madeleine Potter of memaké. This unique lamp, fitted with wool-felt petals to create a dappled shade, incorporates different textures to great effect. As well as sourcing sustainable timber for the base, the designers hope to make a strong sustainable statement by "...resonating over time to become a treasured object which overlooks fashion trends and establishes its own design position and connection with the end user."

## Freefold

This shelving system was designed by Toby Horrocks to hold books, but it can also be used to form a room divider, storage wall or bench. Made from recycled cardboard, each component folds out of a single piece and can be fitted together without glue into any configuration you like and easily dismantled again when you need to move it.
